MSC (Ivanka Kyuchukova/Kelly Mogilefsky) approved the September 12, 2017 PTC Meeting minutes as written.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Presented by Tresa Irby - JP Popoff absent):

- A. Welcomed Parents and acknowledged the PTC Officers & Vice Principal.
- B. Expression of Gratitude to all parents who volunteered to make the 8th Grade Vision Screening a Success.
- C. PTC financial condition – the PTC received 50 percent less this year in direct donations. This, coupled with an approximate, 50-percent increase in the cross-guard fee has left the PTC with approximately \$1,000 to cover items normally underwritten by the PTC.
 1. The PTC has responded by:
 - a. Meeting with the Alameda County Public Works Department regarding funding the Cross Guard - Request Denied.
 - b. Auditing the Crossing Guard Cost - pending
 - c. In the processes of creating a GoFundMe fundraiser to maintain the Crossing Guard position.
 - d. In the processes of starting a “Parent Awareness” campaign (Flyers, Facebook presence)
 - e. PTC Direct Donation form will change to a mandatory form to view during the registration process.
 - f. Purchased a square kit to make it more convenient for parent donations.
 - g. In the processes of reapplying for the Safeway Foundation Grant.
