

Creekside PTC Meeting Minutes

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 6:58pm

ROLL CALL:

MSC (J.P. Popoff/Tresa Irby) approved the October 10, 2017 PTC Meeting minutes as written.

J.P. Popoff welcomed parents, acknowledged the PTC Officers & Introduced Guest Speakers.

GUEST SPEAKER (Paul Keener - Senior Transportation Planner with the Alameda County Public Works Agency):

- A. Discussed the current salary of Creekside's contracted Crossing Guard through the Public Works Agency.
- B. "AAA Safety Program" is a pilot program available to replace a contracted crossing guard. CVE adopted this program last year. It takes 2 weeks to implement the program but requires school staff, parent volunteers and children to run the program effectively.
- C. A Site Assessment occurred this past Spring. Center Street will be under construction in Jan/ Feb to create a turn lane as well as high visibility crosswalks.

GUEST SPEAKER (ACSD Deputy Jason Deitschman):

- A. There are 4 SRO's (School Resource Officers) in CV. They are currently requesting laser radar which are approx. \$5000 per radar. They currently do not carry one which would aide in slowing down traffic speed violators by issuing citations at each infraction.
- B. The SRO's are encouraging parents to attend town hall meetings and express their concerns for the need for SRO's to carry laser radar devices in hopes of reducing the speed on heavily traveled streets during school hours.
- C. Cel Phone Awareness is a huge safety concern among the schools today. You are encouraged to have dialogue with your children regarding this issue in terms of social media, slander, sharing person images, ect.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (Ms. Jaliza Eagles):

- A. PLC (Professional Learning Community) is evaluating goals and trying to meet those goals.
- B. Discussion of budget cuts. Detailed documentation is available on the CVSD website.
