A. Presented a CVUSD Update

1. Website has been revamped - It has a wealth of information at your fingertips.
2. The CVUSD has been named the "California Exemplary School District" for 2018.
3. Both Independent Elementary & Proctor Elementary were the recipient of the "Distinguished School Award".
4. Measure G update - up to date information is available on website.
5. CVUSD calendar is available on the district website. The first day of school is August 22, 2018, but the rest of the calendar is not "concrete" and is still pending.
6. CVHS just completed the WASC accreditation and passed with high ratings.
7. All CVUSD radios have been updated and in full working order.
8. New cameras have been installed on campuses.
