Principal's Report (Jaliza Eagles):

1. Measure G Update – Mat room is 99.9% finished. Still need to finish a few minor things and mats for our wrestling team. “A” wing is still scheduled to begin in February and continue through “B” wing. “C” wing to start next year.
2. Middle School academic summer school will be hosted here at Creekside. More info in the next few months. Intent is around intervention.

Guest Speaker: New Textbook Adoption (Dave Rathjen, KateStickel, and Denise Hohn)

1. History-Social Studies – 3 teachers from Creekside and 5 teachers from Canyon are participating in the Pilot program
2. Started September 2017 with Professional Development and research
3. Publisher presentations in May 2018. Pearson selected for Q2 and TCI for Q3 2018-2019 school year
4. Dec 2018 – Feb 2019 – Meet to discuss Pilot and evaluate
5. April/May 2019 – Recommendation will be presented to the Board for adoption in the 2019-2020 school year
6. Content, Inquiry, Literacy, and Citizenship are the big changes in the new adopted framework
7. Inclusion in textbooks according to the FAIR Act from 2011
8. Display at the District Office from January 9th to February 19th for community review
